## BAS SPORT

### **Netball, Basketball, Soccer and Volleyball**

Games will often be played at Loreto College, however some games may be played at other Ballarat Associated School (BAS) venues including: Ballarat Clarendon College (BCC), Ballarat Grammar School (BGS), Ballarat High School (BHS), Damascus College (DC), Mount Clear College (MCC), St Patrick's College (SPC), Phoenix College (PC). Students will be provided with a timetable at the beginning of the Term.

### **Hockey**

Games held at Prince of Wales Park, Gillies Street, Wendouree, every week with training held at St Patrick's College, Sturt Street, Ballarat.

### **Tennis**

Venues may vary but games generally held at Prince of Wales Park, Gillies Street Wendouree. Please check with your coaches and timetables prior to games.

### **Cricket**

Matches held at Victoria Park, Sturt Street Ballarat, or other BAS venues. Please check with your coaches prior to matches.

### **Football**

Games are held at various BAS venues with St Patrick's College, Sturt Street, Ballarat, considered the Loreto College 'home' ground. Please check with your coaches and timetables prior to games.

### **Badminton**

Matches generally held at Ken Kay stadium, Dowling Street, Wendouree, or at various BAS venues. Please check with your coaches and timetables prior to games.

### **Racquetball**

Games regularly held at the Ballarat Squash and Racquetball Centre, Dowling Street, Wendouree.

### **Croquet**

Games are regularly held at Prince of Wales Park, Gillies Street, Wendouree.

## How do students get to BAS Sport?

For venues that are close to Loreto College such as, Prince of Wales Park, St Patrick's College, Clarendon College, Victoria Park, and Ballarat High School, **staff and students will walk to the sport after the conclusion of the school day**. Parents/Carers will be required to collect students from the venue after their game timeslot.

For venues further than 1km walking distance from Loreto College, **transport will be arranged by the school** and Parent/Carers will be required to collect students from the venue after their game timeslot.

## ROWING

Loreto College's Rowing Program is one of the best Ballarat has to offer, with Loreto's location at Lake Wendouree providing a convenient and inclusive experience.

**Students from Year 8 and above** have the opportunity to join the rowing program which runs from Term 4 to the end of Term 1 the following year (with camps and training running over the Christmas School Holidays). Trials begin in Term 3 each year.

Rowing regattas generally occur over weekends and students are expected to attend training before and after school, several times per week. Bus transport will be arranged for students to attend tournaments held outside of Ballarat.

There is an additional charge to be involved in the Rowing program due to the high costs of the sport.
