Music Teachers/Instructors operate under the leadership of the Learning Leader: Co-Curricular Music Loreto who is responsible to the Principal through the Executive Deputy Principal. It is essential that Instructors always be consistent in supporting the College's vision and ethos by demonstrating a concern for the wellbeing and development of each student, and by ensuring the students exhibit a suitable standard of behaviour, effort and presentation.

The teaching time fraction for Instructors is dependent on the number of students enrolled on a particular instrument. Ensemble direction is an additional responsibility which is also dependent on student numbers.
