Applications for the Eileen Macintyre Music Scholarships for Year 7, 2020 close on Monday February 18

The Eileen Macintyre Music Scholarships offer two scholarships for students commencing Year 7 at Loreto College in 2020 and provide 50% of tuition fees through to the end of Year 12 (subject to recipient meeting the scholarship conditions (below). To provide musical extension opportunities for the recipient, one half hour music tuition lesson per week, on a second instrument (brass, woodwind or string) will be provided, as well as optional group music theory lessons until the recipient completes AMEB Grade 4 Theory. Applicants should have a minimum of three years' experience on their particular instrument and be at a standard equivalent to AMEB grade 2 or above. A personal CV and a letter of recommendation from the student's current music tutor must be attached to the application.

Scholarship Conditions: The scholarship is conditional to the student remaining committed to regular practise and attendance at all music lessons, rehearsals and performances (in accordance with the 'Conditions of the Music Program'). The recipient must actively participate in at least one school ensemble and engage in all aspects of their Loreto education in accordance with the Loreto values. If an agreement has been reached with the school for the student to participate in private lessons outside the school, a copy of the invoice for reimbursement will be required. This scholarship will only be awarded if a suitable candidate is identified through the audition process.

Music Scholarship auditions for students entering Year 7, 2020 will be held from **4.00pm to 5.30pm on Monday 25 February 2019** (for auditions with backing tracks), **Thursday 28 February** (for auditions requiring piano accompaniment)

Audition Requirements:

- Performance of two contrasting pieces (second piece may be on a second instrument)
- Performance of two scales/technical exercises (applicant's own choice)
- Basic aural (rhythmic and melodic) activities – run by a member of the panel
- Questions about the theory of the pieces performed - asked by a panel member
- A short interview to discuss information on their application form and CV.
